Students who transfer into either the music education or music industry program must audition for acceptance. Also they must take placement tests in music theory, ear-training and sight-singing, regardless of any previous classes they may have taken at other institutions.

Requirements for graduation include a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 overall and in the major, a grade of Cor better in all courses required for the major, including prerequisite courses, 120 credit hours, which must include both a minimum of 30 credit hours overall and 12 credit hours in upper-level courses in the major program from Old Dominion University, completion of BNGL 110C, BNGL 211Cor 221Cor 231C, and a writing intensive (W) course in the major with a grade of Cor better, and completion of Senior Assessment.

This four-year plan is a suggested curriculum to complete this degree program in four years. It is just one of several plans that will work and is presented only as broad guidance to students. Each student is strongly encouraged to develop a customized plan in consultation with their academic advisor. Additional information can also be found in Degree Works.
