Online Programs Are Named National 'Best Buys'

Also ranked as “Best Buys” were the Psychology B.S. and Human Services B.S.- the program ranked tied for 18th in the country.

Praise for the Office of Distance Learning came from faculty members who have overseen the highly ranked online programs: Karen Karlowicz, chair of the School of Nursing in the College of Health Sciences.

Distance education students have given their ODU programs a thumbs up, too. Ninety-five percent of those who participated in a recent survey said they were satisfied or very satisfied with the quality of faculty, with the degree of academic challenge and with the knowledge and skills needed for future work provided by their programs.

Andy Casiello, associate vice president for distance learning, said "High-quality faculty, students and programs coupled with a popular online delivery mode make for a winning combination," he added.



On September 25, 2013 Dr. Mohammad Ali Jawad, Internationally renowned surgeon and Academy award-winning documentary filmmaker, gave a screening of “Saving Face” and lecture at Ted Convocation Center.

Dr. Jawad is internationally known for his remarkable skills and plastic surgery cases, stemming from his high-profile work to restore a British model who was the victim of a vicious acid attack. HBO documented

his efforts in Pakistan in “Saving Face”, a short film that was awarded the 2012 Academy Award for best short documentary. “Saving Face” shares the stories of women victimized by brutal acid attacks as Dr. Jawad works to reconstruct and heal these victims. The

Carole Everhart focuses mostly on pregnancies, childbirth and pediatric work, whereas Dee Everhart performs regular annual exams for adults such as pap smears, breast exams, and driver physicals. Their scope of practice also includes some minor surgeries. The clinic does not accept any health insurance, Medicare or Medicaid. All office visits cost \$40.

But although they may not have high visibility in the building they are definitely making themselves known. During their first year in the College of Health Sciences these two full time faculty - Bonnie Van Lunen and Matthew Hoch - and one adjunct faculty - Johanna Hoch - have 17 publications, 22 abstracts, 4 international presentations, 21 national presentations, 4 regional presentations, 4 invited presentations, 3 funded grants, 3 grants in review, and 6 additional grant submissions that were not funded. 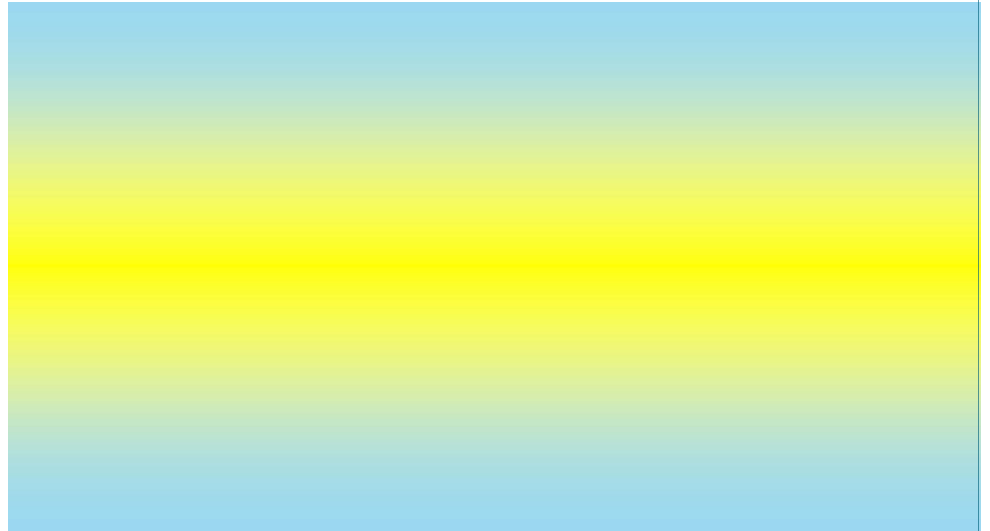
